



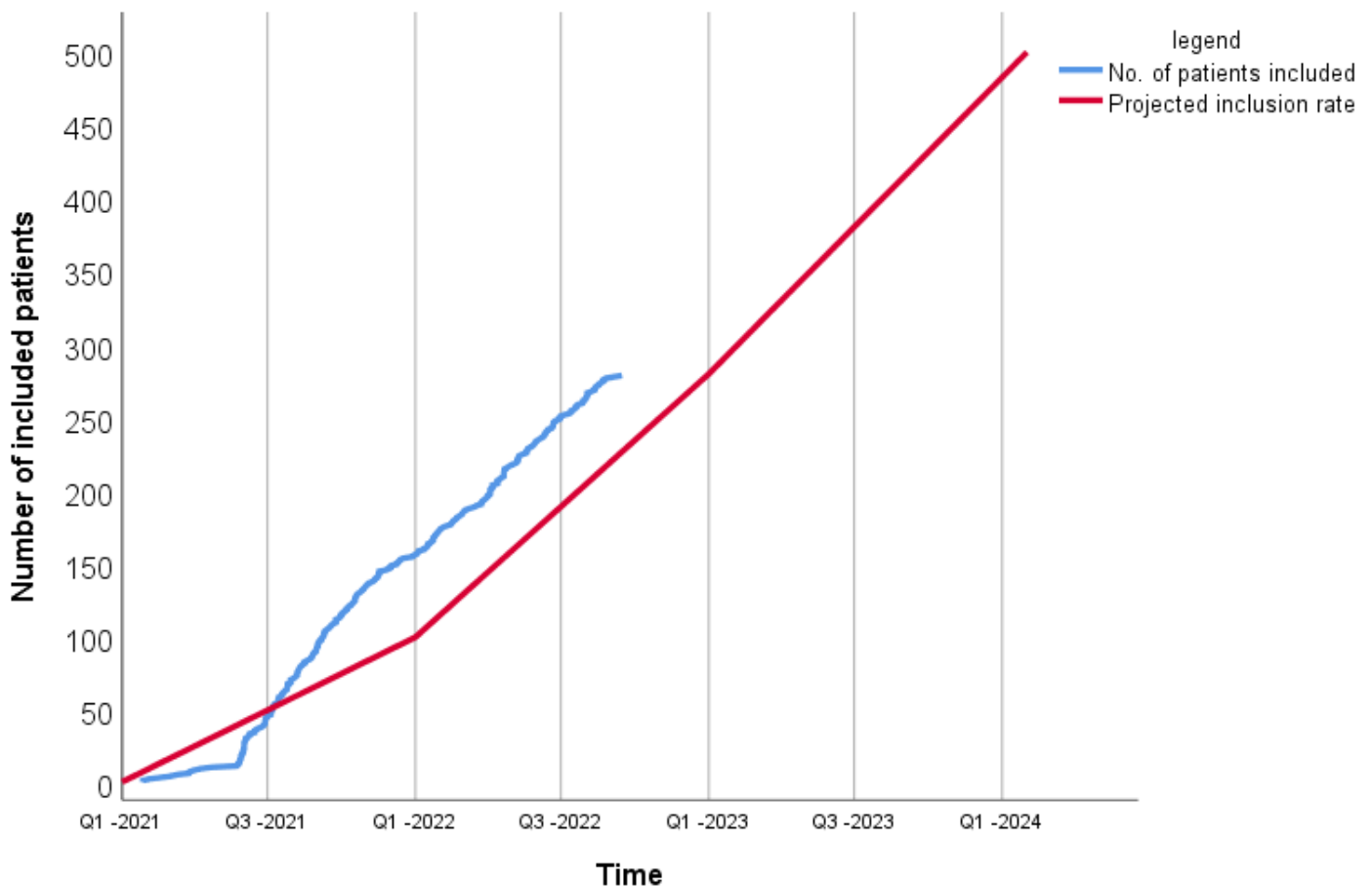

Inclusion rate

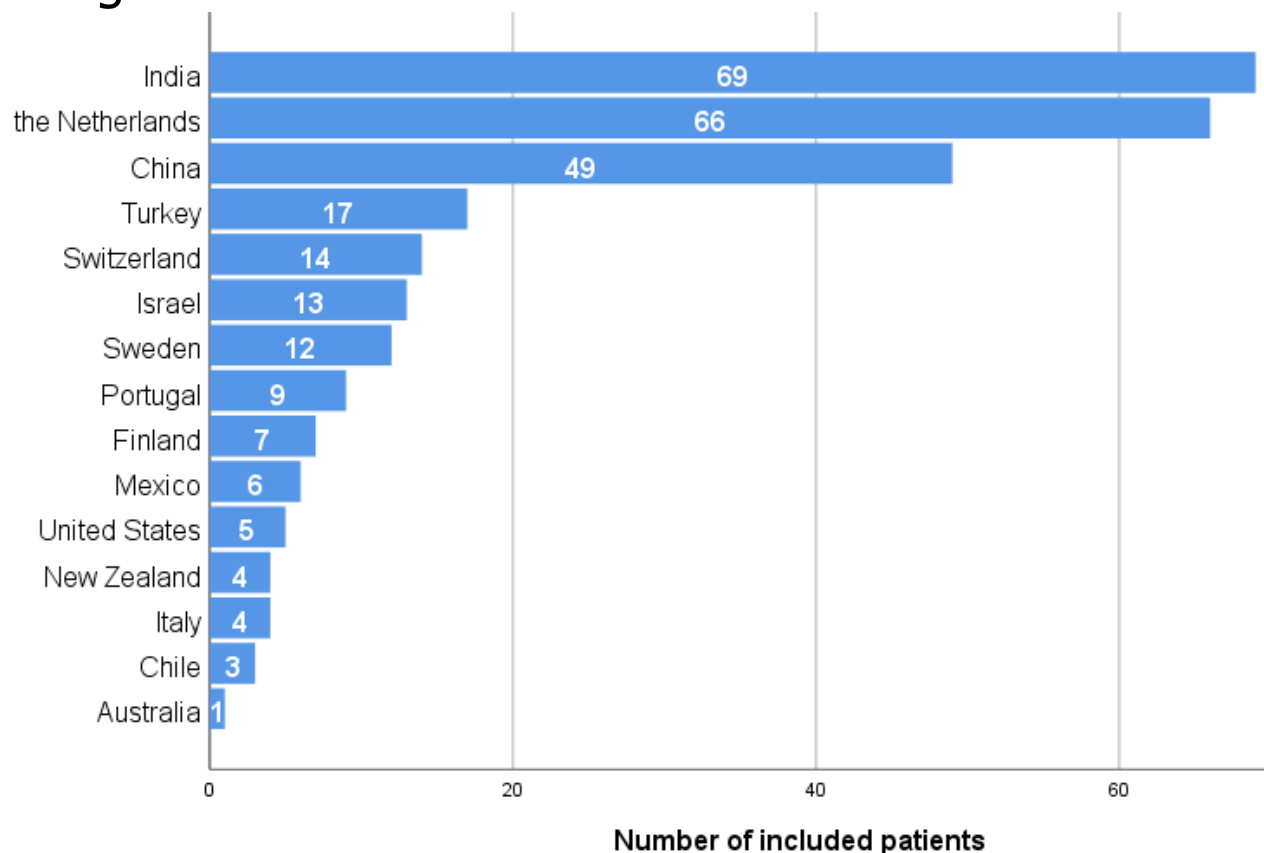
Our inclusion rate is still higher than anticipated! Thanks to your continuous efforts, we currently have **279** included patients from **15** participating countries (56% of total number of required patients).

Important messages

1. We kindly want to remind everyone that the **6-month follow-up moment** is the time-point of the primary outcome of the study. It is therefore crucial that the **6-month follow-up** questions are completed for every patient.

2. Please provide as many details as possible about “events of interest”, including any relevant correspondence and imaging reports. Events of interest are: **bleeding events, venous or arterial thrombotic events, seizures, and new hospital admissions.** These events will be adjudicated by our adjudication committee.
